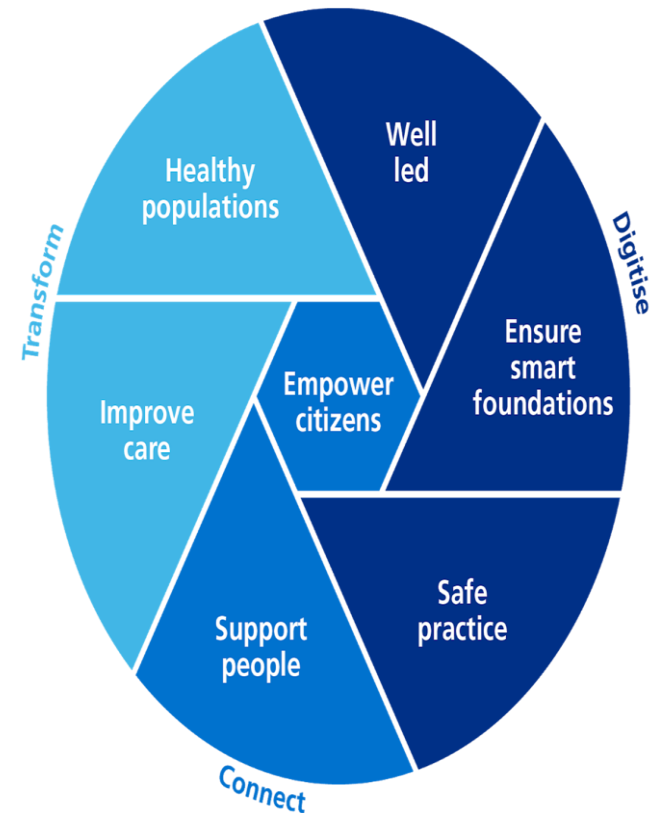


What Good Looks Like - Overview

This work is a continuation of ongoing transformation and guidance, having stemmed from the success of the Well-Led Framework.

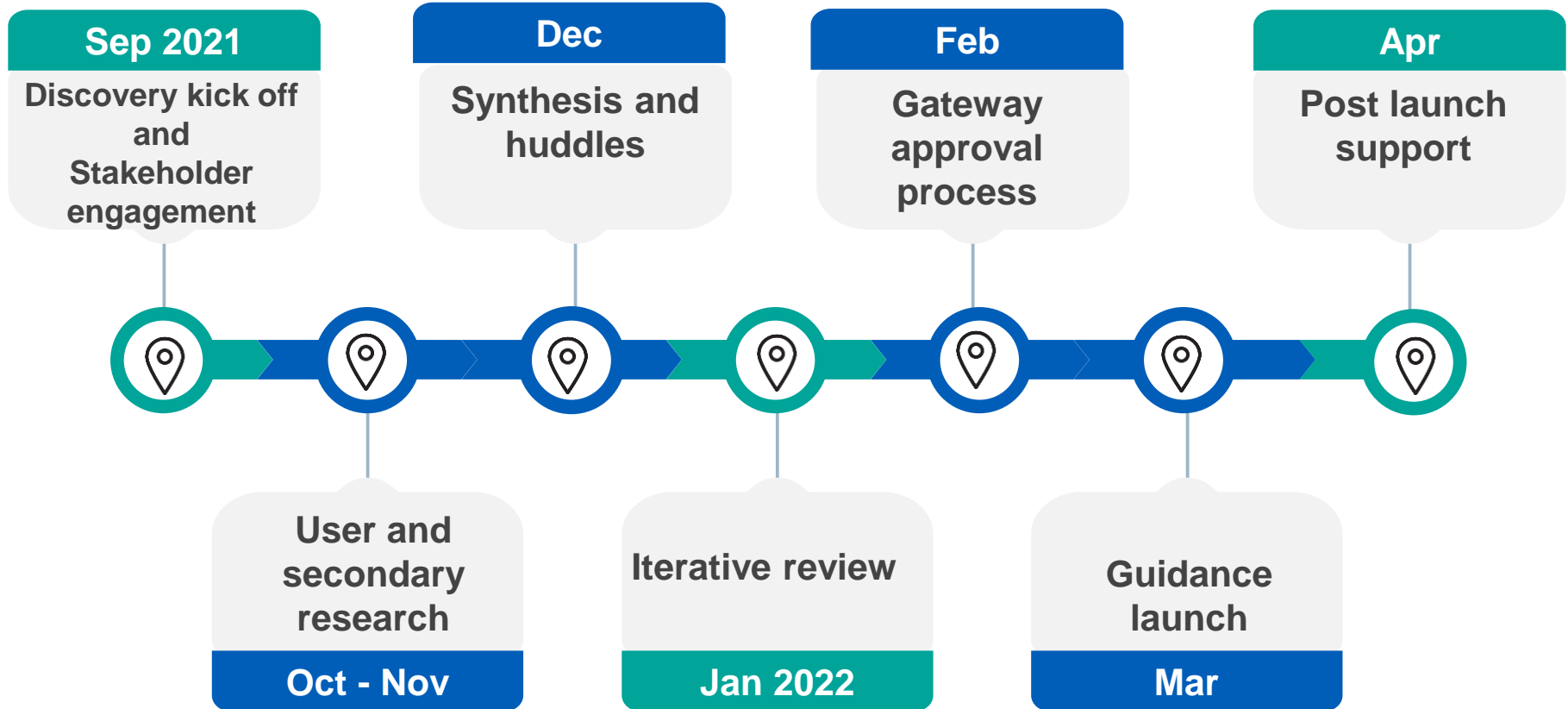
