
My Career Journey – how did I get here?

Lack of digital maturity among staff

Community trusts often not receiving funding or national focus

Do all clinicians need to be digital clinicians?

- 13 nurses and AHPs in first cohort
- 6 taught days with a wide range of experts.
- 6 days to work on a digital project in their service.
- Protected time with funded backfill for all 12 days thanks to funding from the Burdett Trust.
- A mentor from the Digital Transformation Team.
- Myers Briggs profiling and individual follow up.



How did it go?

- Huge interest and lots of applications
- A enthusiastic and energetic cohort who are spreading the message for us!
- Exciting, varied projects including a review of our EPR training offer, an app for frailty support, and an update of the digital audiology system to include more modern content.
- Very positive feedback from the cohort.
- Challenge even with backfill money paid to services, clinicians sometimes couldn't be released for training.
- Highlight One of the participants is joining our team as a digital clinical specialist next month – evidencing that this is supporting a pipeline of digital clinicians.
