












#### Frailty & Dementia





- CIPHA (Combined Intelligence for Population Health Action) a response to the Covid-19 pandemic
- Integrated data primary, acute, social care, ambulance and national (testing and vaccs)
  - Single source of intelligence across 2.6m population 19 providers; 9 local authorities
  - contributed to local (ICS and placebased) actions and planning that linked scientific knowledge to transformational service changes
- Post pandemic PHM transformation programme, SystemP focus on segmented population eg complex lives, frail elderly

## CIPHA in Cheshire and Merseyside delivered the world's first Covid-19 voluntary asymptomatic rapid testing








# CIPHA along with University of Liverpool linked ticketing and testing data to safely reopen the first live music events in the Northern Hemisphere
