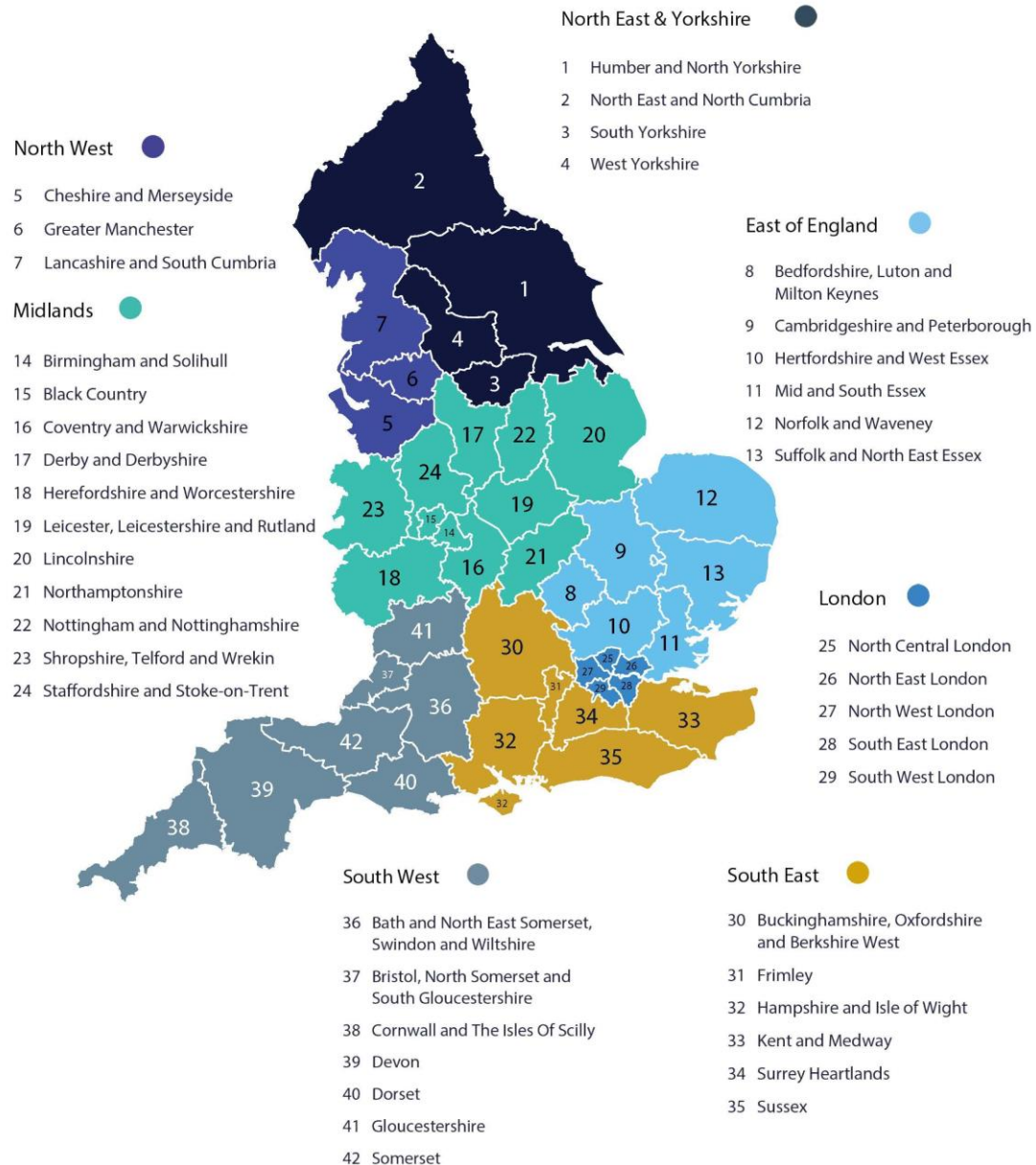


Core Information Standard and the Shared Care Record



All our standards are aligned to ensure **consistency** and **safe sharing of data**

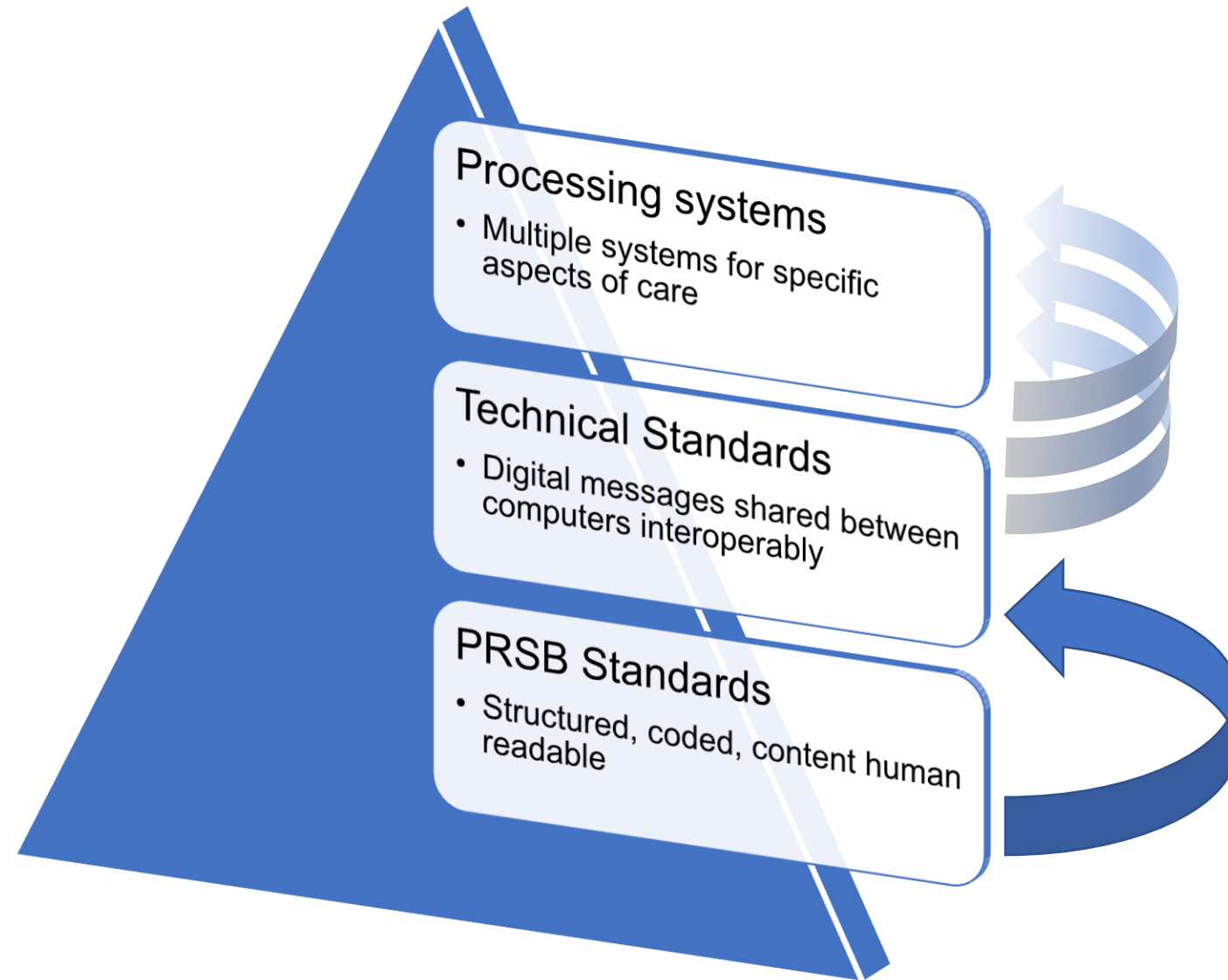
Shared Care Record implementation



- Each of the 42 ICS's now have a Shared Care Record in place
- The WGLL framework specifies that shared care records should adhere to the PRSB Core Information Standard to ensure systems are built with good foundations – this being one of the seven critical success measures.
- As ICSs make progress on their digital journey, more care settings will be brought it, meaning the data on the patient will become richer.

Standards are the ‘rules of the road’ that everyone must follow.

Whatever the local system, configuration or setting, if everyone follows the standards, information can be shared safely”
