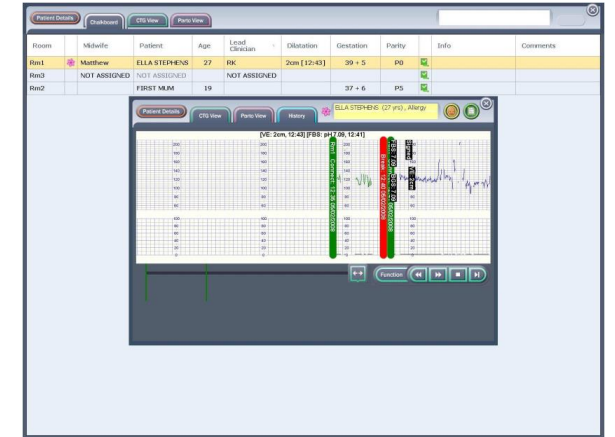
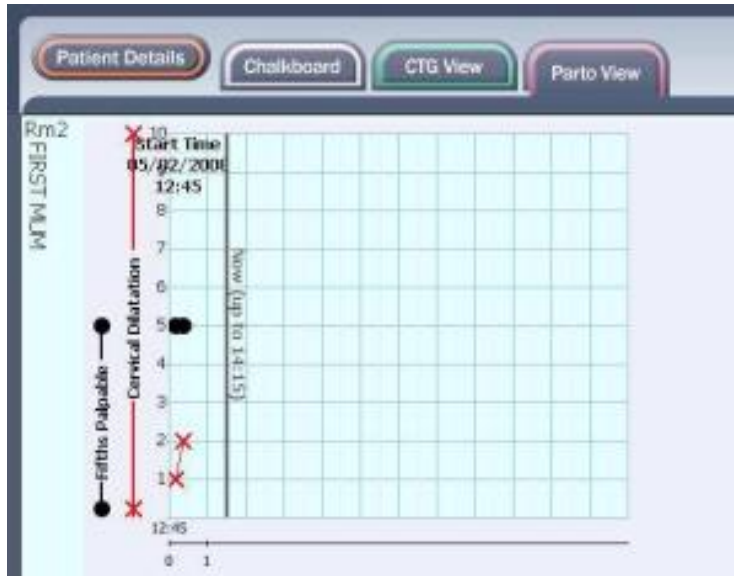

- K2 Guardian Portal available in every delivery room
- Connected to a CTG monitor
- Unified Tec funding
- Business Continuity – offline buffer to still record CTG during an outage
