

Patient experience improves as convenience of care increases when patients can interact with health professionals digitally and have more quality time spend with staff.






WNCR is live in all 8 health board/trust sites in Wales.



WNCR being used in **223** wards across **39** hospital sites. This accounts for **61%** of eligible wards in Wales.

11,238 monthly usersOver 11 k distinct users since go-liveOver 39 k temporary accounts since go-live



86,971 inpatients have been digitally assessed



Over **2.8 million** digital risk assessments completed



WNCR has captured over **3.5million** inpatient nursing notes

Risk Assessments

- Over 1.8 million pain assessments
- Over **394 k** pressure ulcer risk assessments
- Over 230 k continence risk assessments
- Over 223 k falls risk assessments
- Over 218 k patient handling risk assessment
- Over 217 k nutritional risk assessments
- Over 12 k mouth care assessments



105,901 assessments have been shared with our National Repository, making them available across all of Wales.

Over 86k of these assessments have been viewed by another Health Board team ~ 1/5




