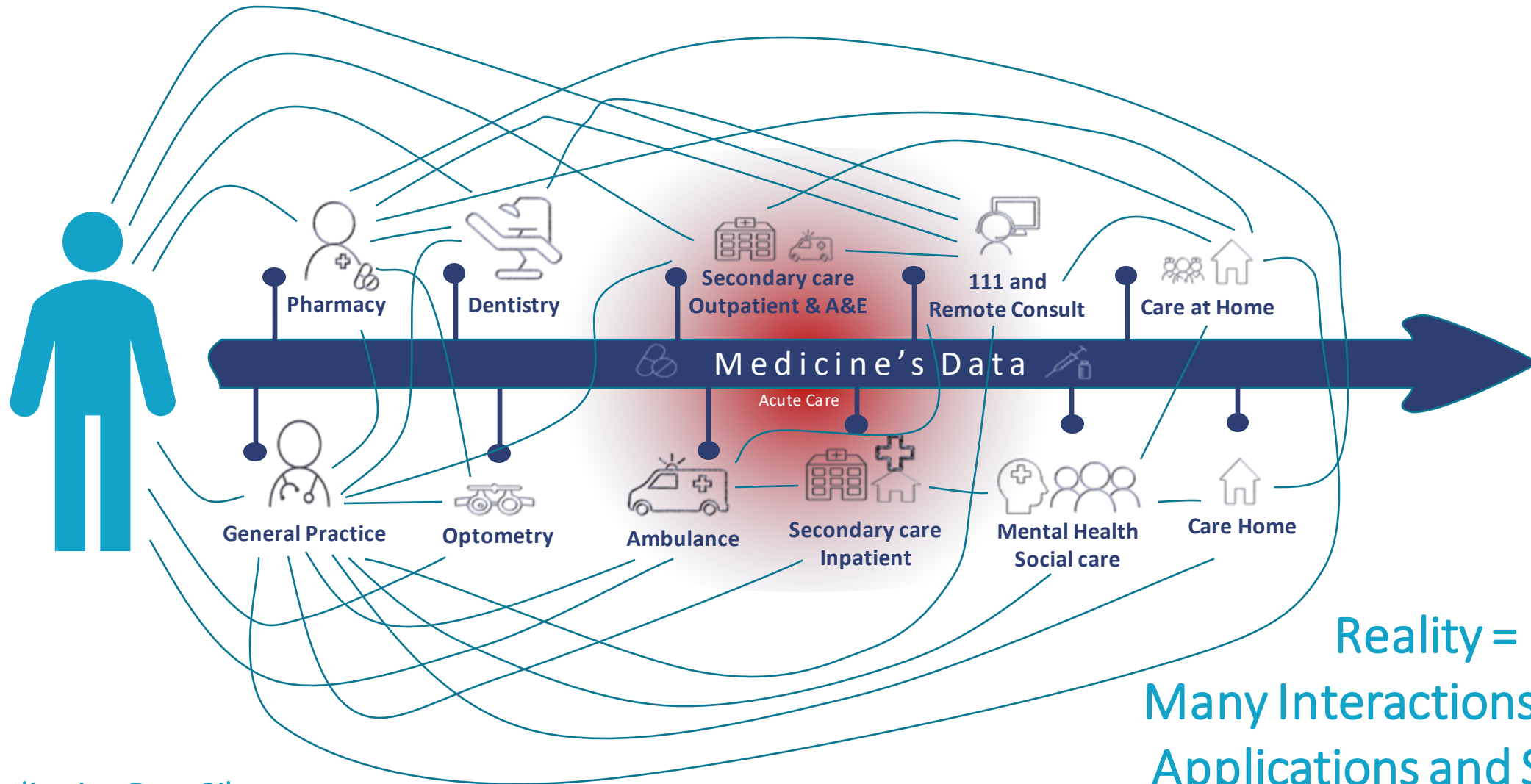

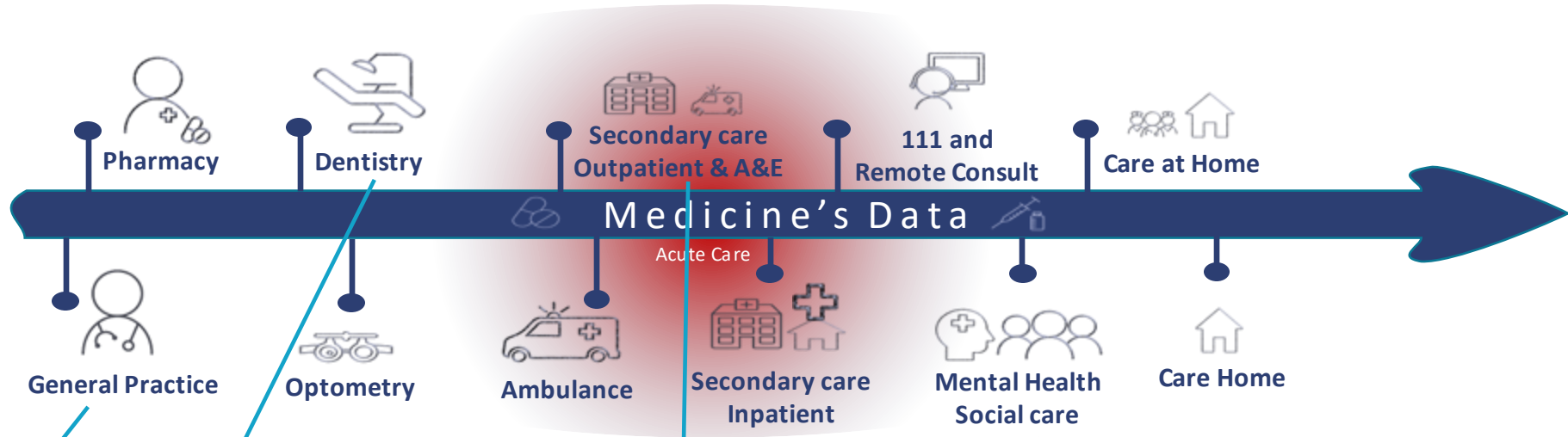
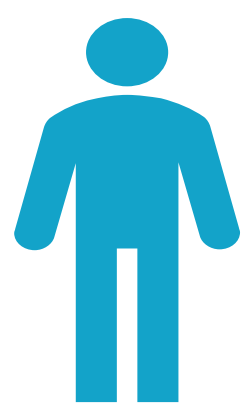

Co-codamol 8mg/500mg effervescent tablets
Dose Instructions: One To Be Taken Four Times A Day
 Date Started: 21-03-2015

Metformin 1g modified-release tablets
Dose Instructions: Take 1 tablet once a day
 Date Started: 21-03-2015

Amoxicillin 500mg capsules
Dose Instructions: Take ONE capsule THREE times a day
Indication: Oral infection
 Date Started: 02-07-2016

Aspirin 75mg dispersible tablets
Dose Instructions: 75mg – Morning - Oral
 Date Started: 02-07-2017

Simvastatin 40mg tablets
Dose Instructions: Take ONE tablet each NIGHT
 Date Started: 02-07-2017

Haldol Decanoate 100mg/1ml solution for injection ampoules
 Give 100mg by intramuscular injection every 4 weeks
 Last Administered 06.08.2023

What is in the Shared Medicines Record?

- Centrally held FHIR Store
- Populated by ALL cardinal events from ALL trusted systems by interoperable FHIR messages
 - Prescribe new
 - Stop
 - Dispense
 - Administer
- Relevant information shared digitally at transitions of care
 - Reducing transcription
 - Reducing error
 - Releasing clinician time to care
- Data is transitioned into the NDR, (both pseudonymised and deidentified) and available for secondary uses
 - Research
 - Audit
 - Medicines management

Creating shared medication records

- Revolves around standards
 - Patient identifier
 - Organisation identifier
 - Encounter context
 - User identifier
 - Medicine identifier
 - 'Meta-data' codes (dose, etc)
 - Message structures and behaviours (FHIR)

Shared Medicines Record APIs (Read only) :

- 1. Read medicines from GP system (N07)
- 2. Read medicines & allergies from the GP system (N08)

Persisted Access

- Patient medication & allergy record stored in the standards compliant FHIR store

- Update the National Data & Analytics Platform (NDAP)

Standardised APIs (Read/Write) :

- 1. Patients medicines (N20)
- 2. Patients allergies and intolerances (N21)
- 3. Patients current medicines*
- 4. Search patients medicines

- View patients medicines and allergies record in a browser

Richer Content

- Open architecture to increase trusted provider systems
- Open architecture to increase trusted consumer systems

- Standardised APIs (Read/Write) :
 - Patients immunizations



Supported by:

- Onboarding processes and artefacts to support consumer and provider system providers
- Available to LHBs and Trusts for integration to their trusted systems

- Dependant on agreed logic
- All APIs must be available via API management platform
- All access is subject to audit
- Standardized API = FHIR (R4)
