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

## How did it work?




- Partnership of equals, no lead provider
- Memorandum of understanding
- Testing assumptions, such as sharing of costs
- Weekly meetings, more when required
- Trusts managed logistics, but independent expertise for contract negotiation
- Collaborative ethos and accountability to each other







- Financial savings in licensing costs
- Support for new customer from existing experienced trusts
- Opportunity to improve performance through tightened contract and shared service management
- Potential to establish supplier / customer user group for greater visibility and input into supplier roadmap prioritisation
