Celebrate every step – we think we have missed lots of timescales but clinicians are pleased with the ones we have delivered

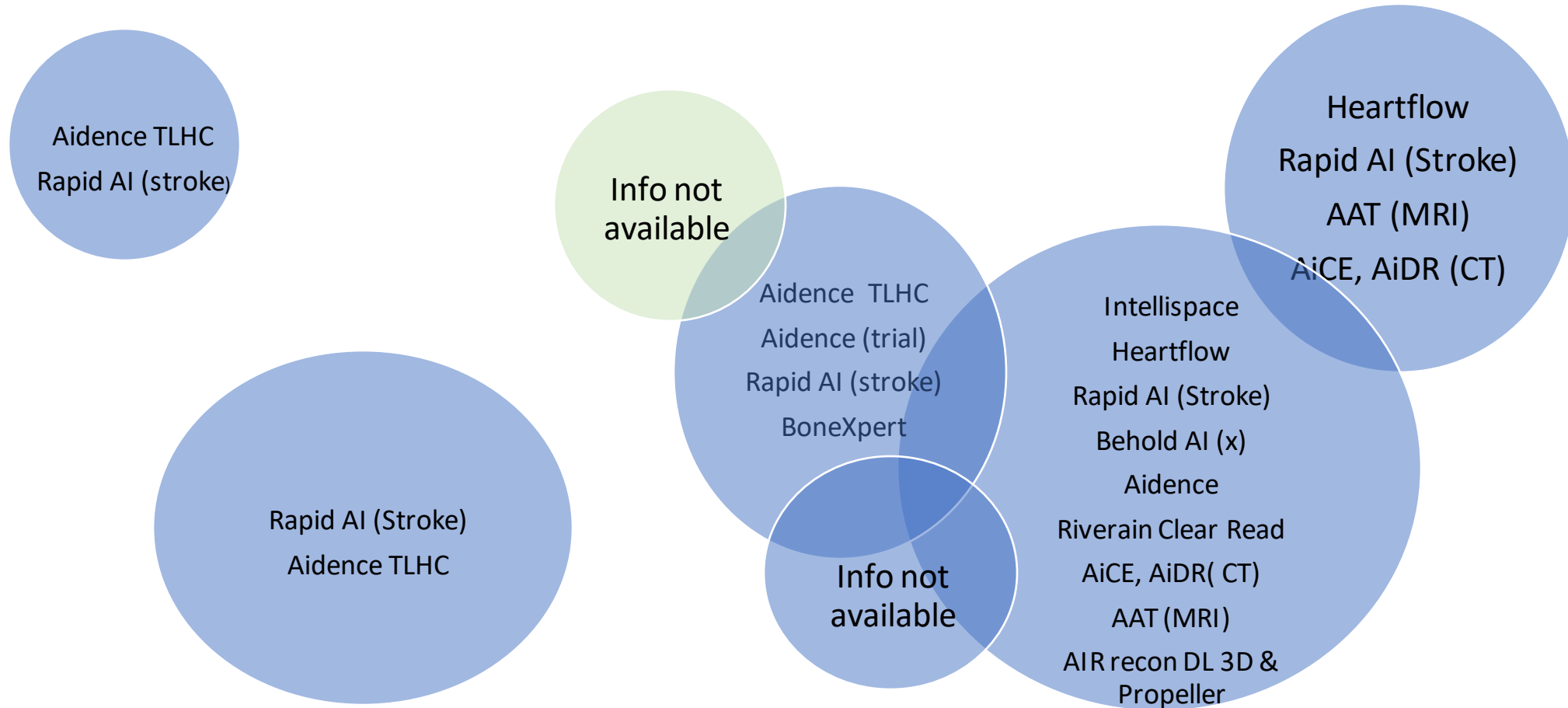
