

Quotes from qualitative research conducted as part of Phase 1

#### **Stroke survivors**

"I didn't understand what type of stroke I had... Even after a Google I still didn't understand what it meant"

"I looked for information online, and it was just worrying"

"The thing I wanted to know was exactly what happened when I had my stroke, but nothing too medical"

### **Family members**

"What I really needed was a good roadmap of local services, or at least signposting to links in our area"

"We needed information for us and resources pulled together for us, making the online search a bit easier"

"Education for the family about what is happening is so important... some family members would get frustrated because she wasn't trying – but we later found out that is part of it"



## My Stroke Companion The Impact



82.5% of people thought that My Stroke Companion was useful to their friends and family

Users' 'good' or 'excellent' understanding of their stroke increased from 31% to 88%


91% of users thought that My Stroke Companion was easy to understand
